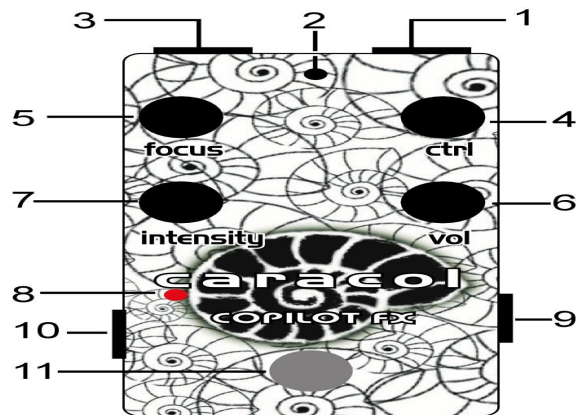


First of all I'd like to Thank you for buying the Caracol (seashell in Spanish).



- 1. In Jack:** Instrument Input.
- 2. Toggle Switch:** Up produces more clean-ish sound while down adds some fuzz character.
- 3. Out Jack:** Output to other FX pedal or Amplifier
- 4. CTRL:** Controls the amount of signal coming in the circuit from the source jack, increasing this knob adds more saturation to the signal.
- 5. Focus:** Shape and filter the signal incoming from the source jack / ctrl knobs, this knob start in the low freq range, increasing it adds more bands to the incoming signal.
- 6. Vol:** Controls the amount of output from the pedal.
- 7. Intensity:** Set the intensity of the pedal, also kinda works as a gain control when the switch is in fuzz mode.
- 8. Led indicator:** Shows the status of the pedal, led will be on when the pedal is engaged, while is off the pedal will be in bypass mode..
- 9. Source Jack:** External source of modulation, when there's nothing plugged the caracol will track the same signal of the in jack, as soon as there's something plugged it will use this jack as source of modulation, CTRL and Focus knobs work directly with this jack.
- 10. Power Jack:** This unit needs 9vDC

2.1mm center negative adapter to work, no batteries jacks are available on the inside.

**11. Stomp switch:** Activates the pedal on or off, the led indicator will show status.

### Warranty:

This pedal comes with lifetime warranty, if something goes bad, I'll fix it. I'll cover labor and parts (this not include footswitches, potentiometer or Jacks) and the user is responsible to cover the cost of return shipping, in case of be necessary please contact me. This warranty does not cover abuse, attempts to modify the pedal or misuse by the user. Copilot FX, will assume NO LIABILITY for this product.

### Tweaking:

Please take a little time to become familiar with the knobs, experiment with your setup pre/post drive/fuzzes/distortion

After you familiarize a bit with the pedal, try using the external source jack, for example plugging a jack and touching the tip with your finger will create a ring modulated tone approx. in the key of B. You can plug other guitar, bass, mics, or any instrument into it. Please note do not plug high voltages (more than 5v) sources into it, if you're going to plug synths, CV stuff put the volume/attenuator/control in its minimum value and start increasing slowly.
